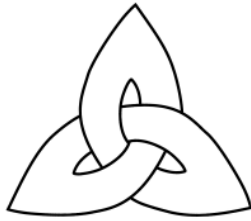
Methodology

The private and voluntary sectors should not be excluded from the process.
